REGARDING GAS SHIPMENT TO OCCUPIED WESTERN SAHARA

The Norwegian Support Committee for Western Sahara refers to a letter we sent your company on 25 April 2020 relating to the shipment of gas from Norway to occupied Western Sahara on board the tanker *Gas Cerberus*. We note that the letter was not responded to.

We have observed that your company yet again is undertaken such operation. On 31 May 2020, your vessel *Eco Invictus* (IMO 9711470) left Kårstø harbour, with destination El Aaiún. *Eco Invictus* remained in Statpipe Gas Terminal, Jetty Number 3, for a period of 14 hours, from 30 May at noon until 31 May 2am in the morning.

It is now 5 June 2020, 15:05 CET, and your vessel is located to the west of Portugal. According to apps like Marinetraffic, your vessel is estimated to arrive El Aaiún harbour Sunday evening, 7 June at 19:00 CET.

We strongly urge your company to take immediate steps to avoid that the vessel completes its journey to the occupied territory.

We are convinced that it is not in the interest of Stealth Corp to become associated with the continued colonization and occupation of Western Sahara, and urge your company to immediately clarify that it intends to steer away from the occupied territory – unless it has first obtained prior permission from representatives of the people of the territory.
